

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between



THE UNIVERSITY OF ANTANANARIVO (Madagascar)

and

THE UNIVERSITY OF REGINA (Canada)

In order to achieve a successful and sustainable partnership, the **University of Regina** (Regina, Saskatchewan, Canada) and **University of Antananarivo** (Ambohintsaina, Antananarivo, Madagascar) (hereinafter jointly referred to as "the Parties") endorse this Memorandum of Understanding.

Both Parties will make every reasonable effort to encourage direct contact, educational, and research cooperation between their constituents, including students, faculty members, departments, and research institutes, and will endeavour to cooperate in the fields with which both Parties are concerned. Within spheres that are mutually agreed to, the Parties agree on the following general forms of cooperation:

- 1. Joint educational and research activities;
- Exchange of academic materials and academic publications;
- 3. Exchange of faculty members for research, lectures, and discussions;
- 4. Exchange of students for study and research.

Themes of joint activity and the conditions for utilising the results achieved and arrangements for all forms of cooperation including visits and exchanges will be negotiated for each specific case. Both institutions understand that all financial arrangements will be negotiated and identified in an agreement prior to the commencement of the associated activities listed above.

It is understood that the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding will commence on the date of later signature, and will continue thereafter for three (3) years, subject from time to time to revision or modification by mutual agreement. Representatives from both institutions will discuss the terms of a renewal at least six (6) months prior to the natural termination of the current Memorandum of Understanding.
