AGREEMENT

Between

THE MARTIN-LUTHER UNIVERSITY HALLE-WITTENBERG

(Federal republic of Germany)

And

THE UNIVERSITY OF ANTANANARIVO

(Madagascar)

Seen the activities undertaken by researchers of the two universities, since the years 1990 on specific themes creating the bases of a collaboration within a mutually profitable agreement. It is notably about works on the Sakalava of Madagascar by Dr Peter Kneitz (of the university of Martin Luther Martin-Luther Halle-Wittenberg), and then on a scientific demonstration that cleared on a Round Table held to Halle (2014), and on the edition of a collective work. Researchers of the University of Antananarivo contributed there by the involvement to the meeting.

Seen the wishes of the Martin-Luther University Halle-Wittenberg and the University of Antananarivo to establish relations of cooperation in the domains of research and the formation, it is suited to what follows:

Section I – GENERAL DISPOSITION

Article 1 - Fields of the collaboration

1. Development and involvement to programs joined of formation and research,
2. Exchanges concerning knowledge and results of research, exchanges of publications,
3. Involvement to common publications,
4. Exchange of researchers and teachers,
5. Exchange of youngsters in formation,
6. Realisation of scientific meetings (shops, round tables, conferences, symposia).
